



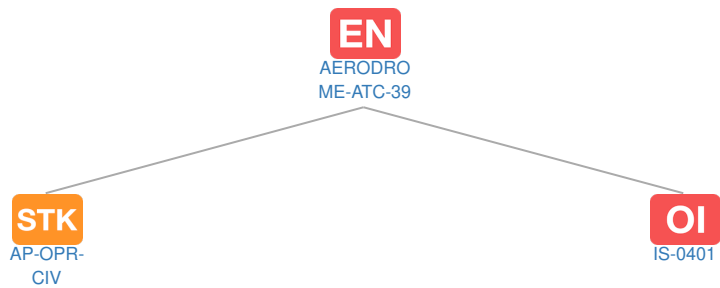
# AERODROME-ATC-39 — Digital ATIS (D-ATIS) provision to the aircraft
